Welcome to the Ann & Sandy Cross Conservation Area

Area guidelines

To use the Area you must agree to the following guidelines:

- User fee in place. Please deposit cash or cheque to the Ann & Sandy Cross Conservation Area in the kiosk fee box.
- EVERYONE must register in the kiosk before using the Area and pre-book at www.crossconservation.org prior to your visit.
- The Area is closed between 11pm and 4am. Access the Area from the lower parking lot only.
- Dogs, horses, or other pets are not allowed on-site. Cars, bicycles and other vehicles are allowed only in the lower parking lot.
- Camping, fires and smoking are not allowed.
- Hunting and discharging firearms are prohibited.
- There are no garbage cans on the trails – please pack out what you pack in.
- Stay on the trails and keep your distance from the wildlife to protect yourself and the animals.
- Leave everything in its place. Do not pick flowers or plants and do not take anything away from the Area.
- Help us to steward the land. Call 403.931.1042 to report any violations of the Area guidelines.



HAZARDS – This is a wildlife preserve. It is not maintained as a park. The entire Area is hilly and trails are remote. Hazards may include, but are not limited to: wildlife, cattle, fallen trees, fencing, holes, mud, ice, water, stinging plants and insects. **Visitors use the Area at their own risk!**
